## **GEN-I, d.o.o.'s Response to Unfounded Allegations Regarding NSi Financing**

**Ljubljana, 11 September 2025** – In relation to claims made in certain media outlets suggesting that GEN-I, d.o.o. “indirectly financed” NSi through a payment of EUR 10,000 to the Janez Evangelist Krek Institute (IJEK), we wish to clarify that these claims are false, unfounded, and malicious.

The only business collaboration involving GEN-I, d.o.o. and IJEK was carried out through the Consortium for Accelerating the Green Transition, which has, since 2019, brought together several domestic energy companies (ELES, d.o.o., GEN-I, d.o.o., Elektro Ljubljana, d.d., Elektro Celje, d.d., Elektro Gorenjska, d.d.).

The subject of the agreement between IJEK and the Consortium, signed on 10 June 2021, was the organization of a conference on the foundations of Slovenia’s energy concept. The Consortium, together with IJEK, organized the conference on 15 June 2021, focusing on the development of Slovenia’s energy sector. Speakers and panelists included directors of four Slovenian energy companies, the president of the Economic Interest Association for Electricity Distribution, the director of the Energy Agency, the director general of the Energy Directorate, and a representative of the organization Umanotera.

GEN-I, d.o.o., on behalf of the Consortium, transferred funds for the execution of the aforementioned event, which were subsequently settled with the other companies in the pre-agreed proportion. As a result, GEN-I, d.o.o.'s cost for organizing the conference amounted to EUR 3,077.00.
